Chair's Report

After two successful summer trips, we had our busiest year yet with more members than ever before. A successful Intro to Climbing and talk by UBES Founder Tony Morrison kicked off the year, with fantastic socials and climbing sessions weekly. Weekend trips ran smoothly, and Scotland was another fantastic success. We ran the Walk Leader Training Series, which has given us a fantastic cohort of new Walk Leaders. After some fantastically snowy weather in the Spring we enjoyed the wintery weather both in the mountains and in Bristol. Thanks to all, particularly Committee, but also to Redpoint supervisors, Walk Leaders, and Drivers!

Treasurer's Report

Report from Oliver Chapman, Treasurer (read by Philip Eccleston, Vice-President)

<u>Key Details</u>

- Membership remains strong with 311 paying members this year
- Breakdown of trip expenditure (average per person, per trip) £24 Vehicle Hire and Petrol; £10 Accomodation; £4 Food; £4 on other costs and £3 to wider budget.
- Increased membership fees form £13 to £15 this year, which helped the Society become more financially sustainable and has given an extra £600 to invest into the Society.
- The Society has spent £1880 so far this year on a breakdown of 60% Climbing, 40%
 Walking and 10% General.
- Largest purchase was £575 into new sets of crampons to replace old and broken pairs.
- More money given out in subsidies this year. 7x£100 Mountain Leader (ML) subsidies and 4x£65 Rock Climbing Instructor (RCI) subsidies (formerly known as Single Pitch Award (SPA)).
- Suggestions from the membership for spending have been sought but they only consisted of a Mitsubishi Delica. More suggestions are thus sought.
